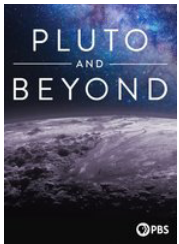


HIGH LIFE

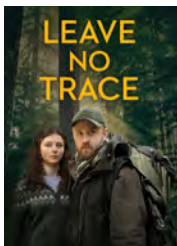

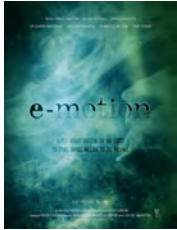
